PART I: ADMINISTRATION REPORT

1.1 Introduction

The Botswana General Certificate of Secondary Education (BGCSE) examination is a syllabus-based assessment where candidates are awarded certificates in respect of each syllabus sat for. The examination was administered to **36 508** candidates from 02 October to 11 November 2019. The 2019 cohort was comprised of candidates from public schools, private schools and individuals who registered with Botswana Examinations Council (BEC). The administration of the examinations was conducted and completed smoothly with a few incidents recorded. Generally the level of adherence to the examinations regulations was recorded at satisfactory level.

This part of the report is intended to provide a background to the environment under which the 2019 examinations were conducted.

1.2 Registration

Registration at this level was conducted through the online facility for both school and private candidates. All Centres managed to register at their respective schools this year while some of the private candidates had to come to BEC for assistance.

Registration of centres

There were 76 Centres that registered candidates for the 2019 BGCSE examination compared to 73 in 2018. These were categorised as follows; 53 school centres (34 government schools, and 19 private schools) and 23 private centres (13 Botswana Open University, BOU and 10 BEC). Two of private schools registered candidates the first time this year while BEC registered candidates in one more additional centre.

Registration of candidates

Table 1 below shows the number of candidates who sat the BGCSE examination in 2019 by Centre type. The total number increase by 12.44% from 32 470 in 2018 to 36 508 in 2019. Government school candidates decreased by 8.23%; private school candidates increased by 101.03% while private candidates (from BOU and BEC Centres) increased by 56.44%. This could have also contributed to the increase in the number of private school candidates and private candidates.

1.3 Conduct of the Examination

The BEC conducts school inspections for the three examination levels through the assistance of the Regional Examination Administrators (REAs), who are outsourced personnel. The purpose of the inspections is to make quality checks on how the centres run the examinations. However, in the 2019 examination cycle the use of the REAs was suspended while their roles and responsibilities were being re-structured and the function being moved to the Compliance and Quality Assurance (CQA) Division, within BEC.

A total of eighteen (18) centres were inspected by Cambridge International Inspector in 2019 while there were 20 in 2018. Of the 18 inspected centres, 6% obtained a “Completely satisfactory” rating in 2019 compared to 30% in 2018, which is a decline in performance of 24.%, 61% were rated “Satisfactory with minor points” in 2019 compared to 40% in 2018 showing an improvement of 21%. Furthermore, 22.0% of the centres were rated as being a “Cause for concern” in 2019 whereas the same rating received 25% in 2018 which is a 3% improvement in performance. Two centres were rated as having “Serious deficiency” in 2019 compared to one and 2018. This preliminary report of the Cambridge Inspector indicated that compliance was at 67% which is a 3 % drop from the 2018 rating of 70%.

1.4 Malpractice and mal-administration cases

For the 2019 examination series, four (4) cases of alleged malpractice were reported at BGCSE compared to one case in 2018. There was also one (1) case of mal-administration and additionally, six (6) incidents were reported. These are shown in the tables 1.2 – 1.5 below.

Incidents

Below is a summary of the incidents and mal-administration cases that were recorded during this cycle.

All the incidents were adequately dealt with and cleared during the time of the examination.

1.5 Marking and moderation

Moderation

Moderation of BGCSE commenced on 16 August 2019 and was completed on 11 November 2019 as planned. The number of moderators was adequate except for Music. Due to shortage of Music personnel, only one group was used instead of two, and that lengthened the schedule for centre visits from 8 days to 15 days.

Cases of non-compliance to the marking criteria were reported and as such some centres had to remark before they could be moderated Computer Studies, Fashion and Fabrics and Music. Computer Studies continues to register re-marking cases as has been the case in previous years although the number of centres has decreased. Fashion and Fabrics recorded the highest number of centres affected this year at 26 out of 30 centres. The teachers from the centres were called at their expense to do re-marking of their candidates work before they could be moderated. The re-marking activity was carried out in the second week of December 2019. The number of Centres that require re-marking is a concern as teachers for these components were re-trained on the marking criteria in July 2019.

Marking

Food and Nutrition Practical

There was an incident recorded at BGCSE Food and Nutrition practical whereby examiners went to the centres to mark the practical examination and later refused to submit candidate scores in October because of unresolved tax issues. The examiners felt that BEC should have intervened in their matter with BURS where they claimed to be owing huge amounts of money from previous years related to marking arrangements. BEC Management engaged the examiners to assure them that BEC had done everything possible but without success. Eventually the examiners were issued with letters of demand which they ignored. Subsequently the matter was referred to the courts, was heard, and judgement is awaited in February 2020. The examiners submitted the scores late November 2019.

Marking of written papers

Marking of written papers started on 03 December 2019 with standardisation exercise for most of the components except for about 5 components that could not start as they had to wait for a few more examiners to turn up. However, by the second day all components had started standardisation. The actual marking progressed fairly smoothly and the payment of the advance fees was done during the first week of marking which left the examiners very happy indeed.

A total of 1 294 examining personnel made up of 1 006 Examiners, 239 Team Leaders and 49 Principal Examiners was engaged in the marking of the BGCSE papers. This was a decrease of 16.57% from the 1 551 total number of examining personnel in 2018. As in previous years, there were shortage of examiners and team leaders recorded in certain components which affected the length of time the components required to complete marking. This shortage mainly affected the core syllabuses like Setswana, English, Maths followed by essay components like History, Geography 2, Social Studies 2 and Development Studies 3.

Strategies employed to deal with the shortage of examining personnel

To mitigate the shortage of examiners the following were employed to cater for the shortfalls:

1. The re-calculation of expected completion dates and more days were added.
2. In some components, team leaders were actually engaged in marking of scripts
3. For some of these components, individual checkers were engaged to relieve the examiners of the excess load of marking and checking so they could concentrate on marking. In all **125 checkers** were engaged for **12 components**.

As a result of the above strategies, most components finished marking in reasonable time

1.6 Access Arrangements and Special Consideration

Access Arrangements and Special Consideration are procedures which are intended to increase access for candidates with special needs to BEC qualifications. Both procedures accommodate candidates with long-term disabilities and conditions as well as those that arise during examinations time. While the Special Consideration procedure addresses those candidates affected during examination time, the Access Arrangements procedure caters for those with long-term disabilities and conditions. The 2019 examination recorded an increase in the total number of candidates registered under this category as compared to 2018. There was a total of **348** candidates who applied for both procedures compared to **137** in 2018.

Applications for Access arrangements

In 2019, a total of **295** applications were received compared to 108 in 2018, an increase of 173.1%. Compared to 2018, the total number of applications for access arrangements increased for all the disability types, except for Hearing Impairment (Deaf & Hard of Hearing). The most prevalent disability continues to be Learning Difficulties, which include conditions like dyslexia, dysgraphia, dyscalculia, attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) and the like. Of the 295 applications, 280 provided supporting evidence while 15 did not. This was a great improvement from 2018 even though

it was achieved through a number of follow up attempts with the Centres. The 15 candidates therefore did not benefit from the access arrangements procedure.

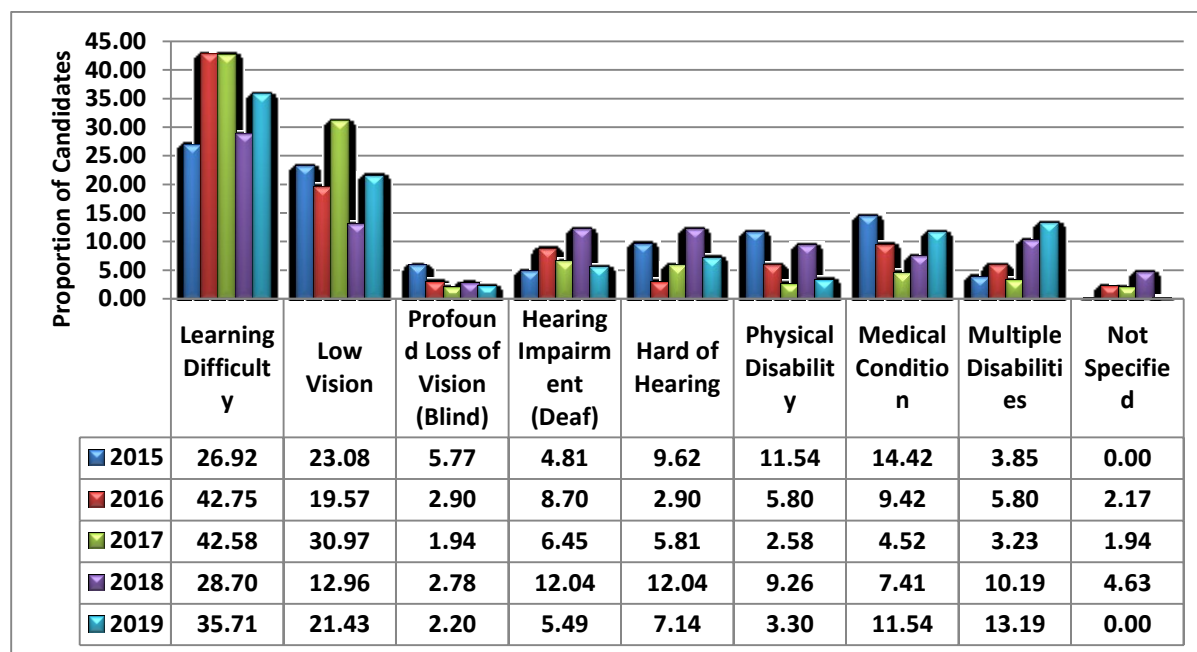


Figure 1.1: Applications by special needs type

Figure 1.1 shows that the proportion of applications per special needs type have increased in Low Vision and Learning Difficulty by 14.42% and 7.01% respectively in 2019 but these special needs types had been showing a fluctuating trend in proportion of candidates from 2015 to 2019. However, the proportion of applications classified under Hearing Impairment (Deaf) and Hard of Hearing had declined by 6.55% and 4.9% respectively in 2019 as compared to the previous year but generally a fluctuating trend in proportion of candidates from 2015 to 2019 has been observed. There is a notable decrease of 5.96% in proportion of candidates under Physical Disability as compared to the previous year.

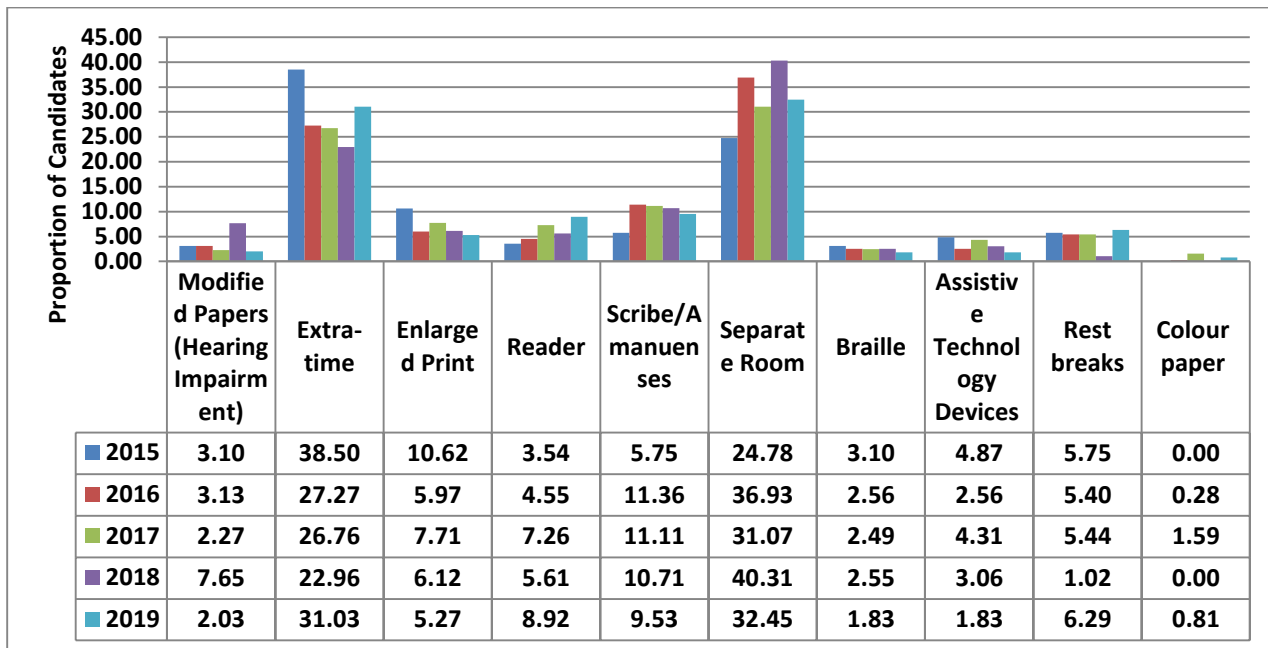


Figure 1.2: Applications by Type of access arrangements from 2015 to 2019

Figure 1.2 shows that in 2019 the proportion of applications by type of access arrangements for BGCSE have had gone up for Extra Time, Reader, Rest breaks. The table further indicates that other types of access arrangements with notable decline in proportion of candidates applied for are Modified Papers (Hearing Impairment) and Separate Room with a decrease of 5.62% and 7.86% respectively.

Applications for Special Consideration

A total of fifty-three (53) candidates applied for special consideration in 2019 compared to twenty-nine (29) candidates in 2018. Out of these, thirty-nine (39) candidates provided supporting evidence while fourteen (14) candidates did not. The observation was that most applications were due to ill health. Applications from all candidates who provided supporting evidence were approved and those that did not were given up to the enquiries period for them to be considered.

PART II: TECHNICAL REPORT

2.1 Introduction

The BGCSE is a subject based qualification graded on a scale of A* - G. Candidates failing to reach the minimum requirements for grade G are ungraded, and assigned letter U, whilst grades G or better represent success in a given syllabus, those that are C or better are classified as credits. In addition to performance at syllabus level, overall performance is reported in terms of the proportion of candidates achieving grades G or better, grade E or better and grade C or better on the best **six** syllabuses. **This section covers performance in government centres only.**

A total of 27 BGCSE syllabuses and 3 syllabuses borrowed from Cambridge International were available at this level. Just like in 2018, the 27 BGCSE syllabuses were examined through a total of 72 components comprising eight (8) Multiple-Choice, nine (9) coursework and fifty five (55) constructed response.

2.2 Final Outcome

Syllabus specific reports

The syllabus specific reports are presented according to the classification in the curriculum blueprint. The blueprint classifies syllabuses into two broad groups of Core and Optional. The optional group is further divided into 4 subgroups as follows:

- Sciences
- Humanities and Social Sciences
- Creative, Technical & Vocational
- Enrichment

In this subgroup of syllabuses, nearly all candidates are awarded a grade in Setswana and English Language, whilst in Mathematics almost 8% are not awarded a grade as they have been assigned

letter U. However, a significant improvement in the syllabus has been recorded at grade E or better and grade C or better suggesting that the quality of the results has improved. Even though improvement is noted at grade E or better, it ought to be noted that performance at this grade level is still very low compared to that of the other two syllabuses.

The performance of candidates in Setswana and English Language at grade E or better is at the same level as that of 2018. However English Language declined significantly at grade C or better, owing to candidates' weaknesses in the skills of comprehension and summary.

The Award Sciences (Science Double and Science Single)

The performance of candidates in Science Double Award had slight variations but generally is at the same level as that of 2018 across grades. The performance of candidates in Science Single Award improved significantly at grades G or better by +2.23% and at grades E or better by +6.37%. Whilst the improvement is noted, it ought to be noted that the majority of candidates (about 60%) continue to be at grades G and F.

The separate Sciences (Biology, Chemistry and Physics)

Of the three syllabuses, performance of candidates across grades G and E is at the same level as that of 2018. For grade C or better, the performance in Physics has improved significantly whilst for Biology it has declined significantly. Candidates demonstrated strengths in Physics practical skills and weaknesses in Biology practical skills. The only logical explanation of this situation could be that learners were exposed to different learning experiences as both syllabuses are taken by the same group of candidates. Even though a decline is noted in Biology, performance in the three separate sciences continues to be the highest perhaps owing to purposely selected cohorts across years.

This year all syllabuses in the subgroup (including History) recorded less than 10% of candidates who are Ungraded. For the syllabuses that recorded the same level of performance as that of 2018 at grade E or better, two of them, (History and Geography) recorded significant decline at grade C implying that the quality of the 2019 cohort was lower than that of 2018. For example, in Geography, candidates demonstrated weaknesses in Research Skills and other skills such as Awareness, Evaluation and Decision making.

It is worth noting that, within this subgroup of syllabuses, Social Studies recorded significant improvements at Grades E and C which is attributed to improved performance in the skill area of Application of which the 2018 cohort was deemed much weaker. Unlike those taking Geography, candidates also demonstrated strengths in research skills.

In the case of Literature in English, it ought to be noted that the number of candidates involved in both years is too small for any meaningful comparisons and hence the results should be interpreted with caution.

The overall performance of syllabuses in this subgroup, with the exception of Business Studies and Accounting, was at the same level as that of 2018. It ought to be noted that the Art & Design syllabus continues to record exceptionally high levels of performance across grades with over 60% of candidates achieving grade C or better.

The Business Syllabuses (Commerce, Business Studies, Accounting)

Commerce remains the most popular of the three (3) business syllabuses and it also recorded significant improvement at grades E or better and at grades C or better. However, unlike in 2018, Accounting has not made any significant improvements across grades but it ought to be noted that despite this, the syllabus remains the best performing within the Business subjects.

The Home Economics syllabuses (Food & Nutrition, Fashion & Fabrics, Home Management)

Of the three (3) syllabuses, Food and Nutrition is the most improved with significant changes at grades E or better and at grades C or better despite performance remaining low especially at credit grades. Home Management remained the same as in 2018 but continues to be the best performing within the Home Economics syllabuses.

Nearly all candidates who entered for each of the syllabuses in this subgroup were graded. The size of the cohort for the Music syllabus is too small (less than 200 candidates) and its composition fluctuates across years and changes in outcomes should be interpreted with caution. It is noted that even though Religious Education has shown improvements at grade E or better and grade C or better, the syllabus continues to record the lowest level of performance in the subgroup as indicated by more than 10% of candidates failing to achieve Grade E.

Overall Performance

The proportion of candidates achieving grade G or better in **six** syllabuses is 97.65% of which 64.87% are Grade E or better. Of the 64.87% Grade E or better, 20.95% are Grade C or better.

Performance as it stands this year compared to last year, shows a significant improvement of 3.56% at Grade E while it has remained at the same level for Grade G or better and Grade C or better. Performance at Grade C or better still remains low indicating that a significant number of candidates do not reach credit grades. It is observed that about one third of the candidates are at the lowest grades of Grades F and G whilst about.

Outstanding Performance

The criterion for performance classified as outstanding in the BGCSE examination is achievement of at least 6A*s in the syllabuses that a candidate may have taken. The prospective number of candidates who met this criterion in 2019 is 11 from 7 centres compared to fifteen (15) from eight (8) centres in 2018.

It was noted that this year the candidates were somewhat spread across the centres as only 3 candidates were from the same centre compared to last year where close to half of them , seven (7), were from one centre.

This year the top candidate achieved 8A*, 1A and 1B from a total of 10 syllabuses which is slightly lower than the achievement in 2018 where 8A*, 2A and 1B was achieved from 11 syllabuses.

PART III: RESULTS ANALYSIS

3.1 Introduction

This part of the report presents an analysis of the final outcomes for all candidates who sat for the 2019 BGCSE examinations. The section will be presented along the following sub-headings:

3.2 Candidature

From a total of **36 508** candidates, **21 838 (59.82%)** were females and **14 670 (40.18%)** males.

Table 3.1 presents the number of candidates who sat for BGCSE examinations across 2 years, 2018 and 2019. A comparison of 2018 and 2019 candidature shows that majority of the centres had a decline of more than 10% in candidature. This is more pronounced in government centres while most private centres show an increase of 10% or more in candidature. It is therefore plausible to assert that the 10% got shifted to private candidature.

3.3 Number of candidates graded for each syllabus

Table 3.2 shows the total number of candidates (school candidates and private candidates) who were graded for each of the syllabi in the period from 2015 to 2019. Generally, as shown in Table 3.2, in the year 2019 there was a decrease in candidature in most subjects compared to 2018. The greatest decrease in candidature was noted in Science Single Award (38.50%) and Food & Nutrition (21.07%). On the other hand, the subjects which showed an increase in candidature mostly recorded an increase of more than 10%. Human and Social Biology has the highest proportion of X, about 53%, showing that more than half of the candidates did not meet the requirements of the syllabus. The subject is taken by private candidates. The other subjects with a high proportion of X (more than 10%), are Mathematics, English Language, Science: Double Award, Science: Single Award, Accounting and Commerce.

Appendix 1

PERFORMANCE OF CANDIDATES IN GOVERNMENT AND GOVERNMENT AIDED SCHOOLS

Tables AP1.1 to AP1.32 show the performance of candidates in the Government and Government Aided Schools in the period from 2014 to 2019. Only candidates in full-time attendance at the schools have been included. The performance of the candidates in each school is measured by calculating the number of grades awarded and the cumulative percentage at each grade. Changes in the performance of candidates in a particular school could be assessed by comparing the percentage of the grades issued which are grade C or better (the cumulative percentage at C). For example, in Table AP1.1 the proportion of all grades issued which are C or better increased from 19.65% in 2014 to 23.32% in 2015, remained the same in 2016 and dropped to 19.66% in 2017 and then increased to 21.11% in 2018.
